Important Details:

- For individuals who will stand-up ski or snowboard, you must provide your own equipment: skis, boots and poles or snowboard and boots. If you do not own equipment, Whitefish Mountain Resort has a rental shop at the Base Lodge or there are many options to rent around the city of Whitefish.
- All lessons start and finish at the Base Lodge. We will confirm the exact location prior to your lesson.
- Half-day lessons meet at 9:30am and end by 12:00 pm, or start at 1pm and end at 3:30pm. Full day lessons meet at 9:30am, break for lunch at the Base Lodge from 12:00 pm -1:00 pm, and end by 3:00 pm. *We do not provide lunch or supervision during lunch.*
- For first timers, please plan for up to an hour for your first initial adaptive equipment fitting. We want to ensure you have the best fit and equipment possible. From there, you will start on flat snow with skills and drills and then transition from there.

Cancellation Policy

There is a 48-hour cancellation policy. Reservations that are cancelled within 48 hours of lesson start time will be charged half of the lesson fee. In the rare case that we choose to cancel your lesson due to extreme weather or unsafe conditions, we will do our best to provide an opportunity to make up that session.
