



Local Ski/Ride Program – 2018/2019

In effort to increase accessibility and consistency of adaptive skiing for residents, DREAM is excited to offer a Locals Ski Program. Lessons are offered at discounted rates for those wishing to schedule regular lessons on set dates from January to March. This opportunity is open for individuals that reside in the United States within 90 miles (one-way) of Whitefish.

Half Day Lesson (2.5 Hours) \$45.00
Full Day Lesson (4.5 Hours) \$77.00

Half Day Lesson (2.5 Hours) \$115.00
Full Day Lesson (4.5 Hours) \$175.00

Military Veterans with a disability from any era participate free of charge.

Rate includes instructor & lesson, lift ticket, adaptive equipment, helmet and goggles (if needed).

Important Details:

- For individuals who will stand-up ski or snowboard, you must provide your own equipment: skis, boots and poles or snowboard and boots. If you do not own equipment, Whitefish Mountain Resort has a rental shop at the Base Lodge or there are many options to rent around the city of Whitefish.
- All lessons start and finish at the Base Lodge. We will confirm the exact location prior to your lesson.
- Half-day lessons meet at 9:30am and end by 12:00 pm or start at 1pm and end at 3:30pm
- Full day lessons meet at 9:30am, break for lunch at the Base Lodge from 12:00 pm -1:00 pm, and end by 3:00 pm. *We do not provide lunch or supervision during lunch.*
- For first timers using adaptive equipment, please plan for up to an hour for your first initial equipment fitting. We want to ensure you have the best fit and equipment possible.

Paperwork

All forms must be filled out and received by DREAM no less than two-weeks before your first lesson.

- Liability & media release (must provide original hard copy – bring with you the day of your lesson)
- Medical documentation may be required for your participation in the adaptive program and permission from your doctor may be required if you have been injured less than a year or have had recent surgery.

Payment

Payment must be received before the first lesson.

Cancellation Policy

There is a 48-hour cancellation policy. Reservations that are cancelled within 24 hours of lesson start time will be charged half of the lesson fee. If you do not call nor do you show up for your scheduled lesson, you will automatically be charged the full lesson amount the day of your scheduled lesson. In the rare case that we choose to cancel your lesson due to extreme weather or unsafe conditions, we will do our best to provide an opportunity to make up that session.
